

CONGRESS WOWED BY NEW DATA, PROCESSES

With the largest professional attendance at any Congress yet the Radiation Congress is described in terms of amazement by old-time D.Scns. They are saying that Ron's lectures at this Congress were like a short A.C.C. Unit more than what you'd expect at a Congress, where there are beginners and people entirely new to Scientology.

The newness and comprehensiveness of data given by L. Ron Hubbard here was the outstanding feature of the Congress along with some LRH Group Processing that set some of the boys back on their heels. You would do well to get a good hold on a set of these Congress tapes and run those sessions of Ron's many times through. You'll get some clues, in addition to some of the best processing ever taped. It's very straight on the button.

Ron covered Radiation and the situation fully in the first day and included a complete report on the research that has been done especially over the recent many months.

On the second day the answer to insanity and psychosis. The lectures concerned the relation of these things, if they are to be called things, to agreement. Included were the new definitions with which an auditor can take apart the problems of sanity vs. insanity in a new way.

The third day Ron presented the new considerations of AWARENESS and gave the scale of havingness, never before released, out of which the largest part of the processes and procedures in Advanced Clinical Unit 15 and 16 have come. Here the subject of the Sub-Zero Tone Scale is just about totally wrapped up.

The group processes, by the way, are all straight out of the new definitions and the new scale.

TAPES AND PLAYERS

The tapes of this amazing Congress are going out fast to auditors and groups. Don Breeding of the Distribution Center, who handles all tape recording and reproduction of tapes, has now done something about the other end of the line. His tapes of the Radiation Congress, put on experimental new equipment through a hi-fi radio mike he built for Ron, proved very successful.

At the other end of the line, however, people have problems with the playing of good tapes, the problems being the bad performance of the tape playing equipment generally available. Comparative junk that costs hi-fi prices, but is not high fidelity but mere furniture, is practically the rule in that field.

The fact is that your group doesn't get as much from the tapes when the player is poor as it would from a good player. And they don't keep coming. If your group is at all large you need an amplifier capable of filling up some space. If you want them to come back for more you need the tops in equipment.

In Issue 39 we told you about the setup. What Don did was to go around Washington, famous for its discount houses (no "fair trade" laws in D.C.), and round up components for a tape-playing equipment that would satisfy the highest requirements, with no regard whatever for brand names, but only for performance.

Demonstrated at the Congress, this system proved out as not only a home player system but as a public address player that would fill the Hall of Nations, a very roomy old place. Here is what it consists of: A Fisher PR-6 Preamp for \$12.49, a Bell Model 212C Amplifier for \$50.00, a Viking Model FF75 Tape Deck for \$62.87, a Tandberg speaker for \$58.16. The complete system is available from the Distribution Center for \$180.00 (our price to you is \$3.00 less than the total of the components!).

This package includes no cabinetry except for the handsome Tandberg Speaker in its own cabinet. The components are plugged into each other with ease and you could have a lot of fun making

your own cabinet or buy one when you get around to it.

Editor Sanborn asked Don Breeding what it would cost someone to go out and buy such a tape playing system in the ordinary market and got the answer that you couldn't, because this is a tape player and hi-fi amplifier and speaker and what people can buy on the market is a tape machine which is relatively a piece of junk. So that's the way it is.

For music, by the way, this system is marvellous. Your editor has heard an awful lot of hi-fi systems and this is the best he's heard.

It is suggested that you can get this equipment on a gradient scale, buying first the Fisher PR-6 Preamplifier and Viking FF75 Tape Deck for \$75.36 and using any available speaker, such as a radio, then get the Bell Amplifier and Tandberg Speaker later.

It's a terrific bargain. By all means get the full system right away, however. You'll be pleased and your group will be pleased. You can sure do a lot with this equipment.

HGC USES "STAR SYSTEM"

The Hubbard Guidance Center continues and increases in results.

One of the secrets of HGC success is the "star system" by which Dr. Lewis simply takes the best auditors, or steals them, from anywhere they happen to be, and makes staff of auditors the best in the business.

One veteran star HGC auditor, for instance, is Fernando Estrada, who has served as Acting Director of Training at the Academy for several weeks recently and is now back on post at the Center.

THE ACADEMY OF SCIENTOLOGY

At the Academy of Scientology in Washington the first professional course is the H.C.A. It is by far best if one has already engaged upon the adventure of Scientology through the books, through some processing, through some group experience, before his professional course. The HCA Course, now taught by D.ScN. Richard F. Steves, who is Director of Training at the Academy, is very condensed and intensive, very elementary, very thorough. There is no time to sit back and take a breather during this eight-weeks course. That is one of the reasons why one should have looked over the subject before his professional course.

Training at the Academy does not completely end at graduation. It is really a professional society in which one makes use of a great many services not the least of these being correspondence with your former instructors about the various problems of doing the Scientology job in the field. This assistance from the Washington staff is practical and valuable to the auditor.

The evening professional course is now taught by H.G.A. Marilyn Routson, an auditor since the first course in Los Angeles in 1950 and a graduate of the 15th A.C.C. Leading to a professional certificate the evening course is designed to make it possible for anyone to get his training while holding down a full-time job in the daytime until completion of the course. Marilyn's enthusiasm for auditing and her comprehensive understanding of Scientology are well known to auditors everywhere.
